

Rules for Registration Video

1. Only the horse(s) being registered should appear on the video.
2. Each horse must be clearly identified by name as it is shown.
3. The horse must exhibit an intermediate 4 beat gait for a sufficient length of time (no less than 8-10 complete four beat strides) to clearly show that this is a natural traveling gait for the horse.
4. The intermediate gait must be of a speed faster than a flat walk.
5. Copies of registration papers from other registries should be provided if the horse is also registered with another registry. All forms must be printed legibly or typed.

Horses with one parent or neither parent registered with NASHA:

1. All the above requirements apply. The running walk, fox trot, classic fino or slick pace will not be accepted as the only gait. The horse must exhibit a true single-footing gait.
2. The video must also show the confirmation of the horse from all 4 angles (front, back, and both sides) with no saddle on.
